NIGHT-TIME LANE CLOSURES ON U.S. 64 IN WAKE COUNTY TONIGHT

RALEIGH — Lane closures will be in effect for U.S. 64 East and West in Apex overnight tonight as work continues for the N.C. Turnpike Authority's Western Wake Freeway. One lane in each direction will be closed from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. for 1,500 feet in both directions from its intersection with Kelly Road, with one lane to remain open in each direction.

Both turn lanes from U.S. 64 to Kelly Road will also be closed. Motorists trying to turn onto Kelly Road will have to utilize one of the median turnarounds on U.S. 64.

These closures are taking place to allow the contractor to safely remove a concrete island that is in conflict with proposed traffic.

NCDOT reminds motorists to watch signs for construction information, stay alert and obey the posted speed limit.
