**LANE CLOSURES ON U.S. 1 NEXT WEEK IN WAKE COUNTY**

**RALEIGH** — One of two lanes on U.S. 1 North and South will be closed between N.C. 55 and New Hill Holleman Road in Wake County Monday, Oct. 17 through Saturday, Oct. 22 as the contractor for the Western Wake Freeway grades and paves a temporary widening against the median guardrail. This temporary widening will allow traffic to be shifted to the inside in a later phase. The closures will take place daily between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., weather permitting.

One lane will remain open in each direction.

NCDOT reminds motorists to watch signs for construction information, stay alert and obey the posted speed limit.
