TRAFFIC SHIFT BEGINS TOMORROW ON KELLY ROAD IN WAKE COUNTY

RALEIGH — Traffic on Kelly Road, in Apex, between U.S. 64 and Olive Chapel Road will be shifted onto a temporary roadway beginning at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Oct. 18.

This shift will allow the contractor for the N.C. Turnpike Authority's Western Wake Freeway to build a new ramp that will connect Kelly Road to U.S. 64. Traffic will use the temporary roadway until the end of December.

NCDOT reminds motorists to watch signs for construction information, stay alert and obey the posted speed limit.
