PORTION OF OLD HOLLY SPRINGS APEX ROAD TO CLOSE MONDAY

RALEIGH — A section of Old Holly Springs Apex Road will be closed between Woods Creek Road and Apex Peakway in Holly Springs beginning Monday, Oct. 10 to construct a new bridge over the N.C. Turnpike Authority's Western Wake Freeway. The closure is scheduled to be in place for ten months

Motorists are advised to use the signed detour route on Apex Peakway and the N.C. 55 Bypass to get around the closure.

NCDOT reminds motorists to watch signs for construction information, stay alert and obey the posted speed limit.
